

## Kiddush for Festival Evenings: Pesach, Shavuot and Sukkot including Festivals that fall on Friday or Saturday night

*On Friday nights begin with the first half of the Friday Night Kiddush,  
("Vayehi erev vayehi voker, yom hashishi... Vayechulu hashamayim..." ETC.)  
then continue here with "Baruch ata..."*

We bless you, Sovereign God, who rules  
Eternal space and time  
Creator of the grapevine's fruit,  
From which we make this wine.

Both time and space complete;  
You made us holy with your laws,  
Told us in booths to take a seat
