## Kiddush for Rosh Hashanah Evening

## including when it falls on a Friday or Saturday night

On Friday nights begin with the first half of the Friday Night Kiddush, ("Vayehi erev vayehi voker, yom hashishi... Vayechulu hashamayim..." ETC.) then continue here with "Baruch ata..." adding the words in parentheses NOTE: The website audio file is for a holiday that falls on a weeknight.

On Saturday night continue with Havdalah on next page. Otherwise, conclude with "Shehecheyanu" on next page. Blessed are You, Adonai our God, Ruler of the universe, creator of the fruit of the vine. Blessed are You, Adonai our God, Ruler of the universe, who chose us out of all the nations, and exalted us above all peoples, and made us holy with His commandments. You gave us, Adonai our God, with love this (Shabbat and this) Day of Remembrance, a day for (mentioning) blowing the shofar, a sacred assembly marking the Exodus from Egypt. For out of all the nations You chose us and made us holy, and Your word is true and reliable forever. Blessed are You, Adonai, Ruler over the entire earth, who sanctifies (Shabbat,) Israel and the Day of Remembrance.
