Barukh atah Adonai, Eloheinu melekh ha-olam, asher kid'shanu b'mitzvotav v'tzivanu al n'tilat yadayim. Praised are You Adonai our God, who rules the universe, instilling in us the holiness of mitzvot by commanding us to rinse our hands.

Before eating bread:

Barukh atah Adonai, Eloheinu melekh ha-olam, ha-motzi lehem min ha-aretz.

Praised are You Adonai our God, who rules the universe, bringing forth bread from the earth.

Before eating foods made of the five grains of Israel — wheat, barley, oats, rye, or spelt:

Before eating fruit:

Barukh atah Adonai, Eloheinu melekh ha-olam, borei pri ha-etz. Praised are You Adonai our God, who rules the universe, creating the fruit of the tree.

Before eating vegetables (from plants which sprout annually):

בּרוּך אַתַּה יהוה אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֵלֶךְ הָעוֹלֶם, בּוֹרֵא פְּרִי הָאַדָמָה.

Barukh atah Adonai, Eloheinu melekh ha-olam, borei pri ha-adamah.

Praised are You Adonai our God, who rules the universe, creating the fruit of the earth.

Before drinking wine or grape juice:

בּרוּך אַתָּה יהוה אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, בּוֹרֵא פְּרִי הַגֶּפֶּן.

Barukh atah Adonai, Eloheinu melekh ha-olam, borei pri ha-gafen. Praised are You Adonai our God, who rules the universe, creating the fruit of the vine.

Before partaking of other foods or liquids:

Blessings before a meal

We prepare for the b'rakhah over bread by washing our hands, as follows: Pour water from a cup two or three times over each hand, alternating hands. This b'rakhah and the following one are recited without verbal interruption:
