We are starting "Wednesday Night Men's Basketball" for JCCP/CBT members, ages 30-50 (approximately!).

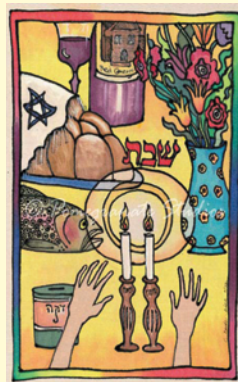
