Please join us on Wednesday evening, July 29<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 PM as we begin the observance of *Tisha B'Av*, the saddest day of the year in the Jewish calendar. Tisha B'av, The Fast of the Ninth of the Hebrew month of Av, is a day of mourning that commemorates the destruction of the first and second Temples, as well as many other tragedies that have befallen the Jewish people. Our service will include the Ma'ariv service and chanting of the Megillat Eichah (Lamentations) by Cantor Weiss and JCCP/CBT members.

Thursday morning, July 30<sup>th</sup> , 2020 at 7:00 AM

The morning service for Tisha B'Av is unlike any other morning service of the year. Following the tradition of Rabbi Meir of Rothenburg of the 13th century, we do not wear Talit or Tefillin at the Shacharit service. Following the service, we mourn for the martyrs of our people on this day reciting special prayers called *Kinot*. This special section will be introduced and led by Cantor Weiss.

Thursday afternoon, July 30<sup>th</sup> 2020 at 2:30 PM

A special early Mincha Service will be held at 2:30 pm on Tuesday afternoon. During the Mincha Service, Talit and Tefillin are worn, signifying the waning of the intense sorrow of the day.

Please join us for the observance of this significant day in the calendar, so that we may make real the words of our Sages, who taught that "...those who mourn the destruction of Jerusalem will one day be granted the merit to see its glorious redemption."
