Jews Down Under: The History of the Jews of Australia and New Zealand

This winter, join Rabbi Arthur Weiner for a six-week exploration of one of the most fascinating and least-known Jewish Communities in the world. ***Jews Down Under: The History of the Jews of Australia*** traces the remarkable journey of Jewish life from the first convict transports and colonial settlements through the Gold Rush era, the founding of modern synagogues and communal institutions, the arrival of refugees and Holocaust survivors, and the vibrant, diverse communities that flourish today. Through a clear historical narrative, this course examines how Jews adapted to life at the edge of the British Empire, shaped political and cultural life in two young nations, and built strong, resilient Jewish identities far from traditional centers of Jewish life.

Whether you love Jewish history, enjoy learning about global Jewish communities, or simply want to warm up your winter with stimulating learning, this course will deepen your understanding of a remarkable corner of the Jewish world.
